Dear Pharmacist:

This notice is to inform you of an important change in the way that Health Kentucky/Kentucky Physicians Care patients (KPC) receive their Novolin brand insulin and/or Prandin.

- Participating KPC pharmacies will no longer be able to process claims for these medications for KPC patients effective **March 1, 2007**
- If your pharmacy dispensed Novo Nordisk products through the Health Kentucky/Kentucky Physicians Care Program **prior to March 1, 2007 you will receive replenishment products**
- Novo Nordisk has requested that **All KPC patients** currently receiving these medications complete a Novo Nordisk Patient Assistance Program application to verify continued eligibility
- We are continuing to work with Novo Nordisk to insure a smooth transition from the bulk replenishment program to their Patient Assistance Program. Novo Nordisk is committed that no eligible patient will have to go without their medication. Additional information will be forthcoming as soon as it's available.
